

How do I reach Hingham emergency personnel?

Includes instructions for residents with certain disabilities & special circumstances

Hingham uses the Enhanced 911 emergency telephone system.

Remember that 911 is for **emergencies only**.

For non-emergencies, please call 781-749-1212 (Hingham Police Dept.) or 781-749-2424 (Hingham Fire Dept.).

Ways to reach 911

Dial 911 from a landline

Dial 911 from a cell phone

If you are hearing or speech impaired

- You can reach 911 with a TTY. The Enhanced 911 System is fully TTY capable and call takers are trained to use TTYs.
- You can dial 911 with a landline. Do not hang up until help arrives. If call gets disconnected or you cannot speak, the 911 call taker has immediate access to the address of which call came from.
- You can dial 911 using a cell phone. While exact address of a cell phone call cannot be tracked, the dispatcher will be able to locate the general area the call came from.
- You can text 911 (Download [Instructions](#) from Mass.Gov).
