Thank you for all of the work that you do in support of this beautiful town, and community.

My husband Craig (copied here) and I live at 6 Bishops Lane. We have been in our home for just over two years. The moment we saw the property, we knew it was home. The tucked away lane, natural beauty and wildlife, create a little sanctuary that never ceases to amaze us. We are very grateful for this, and for our community of neighboring young families. We have two toddler boys. It is a dream to see kids able to freely run to play in neighbors yards. This is the kind of environment we want to raise our children in, for their overall well-being and most importantly, safety. The project that the Young Family Trust is proposing would take all of that away from our young family, and all our neighbors and their families. Furthermore, the plans that Mr. Young has shared with us would introduce many safety concerns for our children including years of living in an active construction zone, extensive large construction vehicle traffic, introducing significantly more general road traffic in the long run, and a concerning amount of significantly extensive blasting that would need to occur. The blasting would also have strong potential to impact our property in a detrimental way, given our proximity and positioning.

We are NOT in favor of this project, and will look forward to seeing you in the May 15 meeting.
