More benefits to the town (w/regards to  
proposed PB courts):

It's more sensible for the town to have courts  
used solely for PB - in an already designated  
recreation area - rather than to continue  
CONVERTING and RETRO-FITTING town  
tennis courts, repainting lines, replacing  
nets, straps, clasps (which endure  
unnecessary wear and tear with the  
constant adjusting and readjusting) year-in  
and year-out.

It is also safer to have each sport played on

its own appointed court rather than encourage dual-use courts; side-by-side play of PB/tennis is significantly more dangerous (w/increased potential liability) when factoring in flying, rolling balls, #'s of players focused on their own game in one appointed space.
